

## SOIL LEGEND

Soil map symbols and map unit names are alphabetical. The first letter of the map symbol, always a capital, is the initial letter of the soil name. The second letter is a small letter, except in associations and undifferentiated map units, in which case it is a capital letter, and identifies either the second named taxon in the map unit or is used for alphabetical purposes. The third letter, if used, is always a capital and indicates the class of slope. The fourth character, if used, is always a number and indicates an eroded phase of the map unit.
