


A R K A N S A S

- 1 Sharkey association: Nearly level, poorly drained soils that have a clayey subsoil; formed in Mississippi River alluvium.
- 2 Grenada-Calhoun association: Gently sloping to level, moderately well drained soils that have a loamy subsoil; formed in loess.
- 3 Calhoun-Grenada association: Level to gently sloping, poorly drained and moderately well drained soils that have a loamy subsoil; formed in loess.
- 4 Dundee-Dubbs association: Level and nearly level, somewhat poorly drained and well drained soils that have a loamy subsoil; formed in loamy alluvium.
- 5 Forestdale-Perry association: Level and nearly level, poorly drained soils that have a clayey subsoil; formed in clayey Arkansas and Mississippi River alluvium.
